If you have fewer than 30 transferable college credits, you can also send your official high school transcript or GED scores to help complete your application. Transferable credits from outside the U.S. are welcome when validated by a UMGC-approved international credential evaluator. Submitting your official transcript(s) as soon as possible ensures you can continue enrolling in additional courses and maintain eligibility for financial aid without interruption.

Note: UMGC credits cannot be used as transferable credits to meet the high school completion requirement.
